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

NATURAL

The City of Marianna has a 4-inch 125 PSI HDPE line bisecting the property from east to west. The line has approximately 277.1 dekatherms (277,100 mcf) available.

The City of Marianna has a 10-inch line with 1,416,000 gallons per day of excess capacity located approximately 500-feet east of the site along Highway 71. WTP has permitted capacity of 5,328,000 gallons per day. Excess capacity factoring in average utilization is 3,928,000 gallons per day.

WASTE-WATER

The City of Marianna has a 12-inch gravity sewer line with 800,000 gallons per day excess capacity one mile southeast of the site. The FCI Lift Station, located west of the airport, has an excess capacity of 500,000 gallons per day. WWTP has permitted capacity of 4 million gallons per day and excess capacity

of 2.2 million gallons per day factoring in peak utilization. Source: Jim Dean, City Manager; August 2021

DUE DILIGENCE

PHASE I ESA

Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment conducted in June 2021 revealed no evidence of recognized environmental conditions.

WETLANDS

No wetlands are present on the property. Formal Wetland Determination (FWD-063-9725-2) was issued by the Northwest Florida Water Management District on August 30, 2021.

SPECIES

An Environmental Ecological Assessment completed in May 2021 stated, "It is our opinion that the subject property does not harbor any listed species, unique habitat, geological outcrops, sinkholes, or other active karst features."

ARCHAEOLOGICAL

The State Historic Preservation Office stated in February 2014 that it was their opinion that the proposed project will have no effect on historic properties on the NRHP or on properties that may be ineligible for the NRHP but are otherwise significant.

GEOTECHNICAL

A Report of Limited Geotechnical Evaluation was completed in January 2014 with six soil borings. The site is classified as Seismic Site Class D.

BUILDABLE AREA



Property contains no wetlands or Threatened/Endangered Species. Gas line dissecting property may be an impediment to potential developer.

Marianna Comp Plan allows for a maximum 90% lot coverage and a maximum height of 70'. Policies: 1.1.4(f)(2) Intensity, and 1.1.4(f)(3).
